## Miguel Martín

He is also a Professor of Medical Oncology at the Complutense University of Madrid. Since 1990, Prof. Martín is fully devoted to breast cancer research and treatment. His main areas of research are systemic treatment of breast cancer, where he has led many national and international clinical trials, and genomic/molecular characterization of breast cancer. Prof. Martín has published more than 250 articles in peer-reviewed medical journals. Prof. Martín is the Chairman of GEICAM (Spanish Group for Breast Cancer Research), a cooperative network involving more than 170 Spanish institutions. He is a founder member of CIRG-Cancer International Research Group, an International Cooperative Group (now named TRIO).

Since 2001, Prof. Martín serves as a member of the Board of Directors and of the Scientific Steering Committee of TRIO (Translational Research in Oncology), an international non-profit clinical research organization of 2000 investigators and 450 cancer centers in over 45 different countries. From October 2015-October 2017, Dr. Martín held the position of President of the Spanish Society of Medical Oncology (SEOM). Additionally, he is a full member of several scientific societies, including ASCO (American Society of Medical Oncology), ESMO (European Society for Medical Oncology), ASBD (American Society of Breast Diseases), among others.

In 2017, Prof. Martín received the 2017 ESMO Award in recognition for his involvement in the organization of cooperative research networks particularly in the field of breast cancer. In the same year, Dr. Martín was awarded with the Obieta Prize, from the Spanish Royal National Academy of Medicine due to his professional accomplishments throughout 2017 as well as his role in research and support in the fight against breast cancer.
