Miguel Martin is Head of Medical Oncology Service (Hospital General Universitario Gregorio Marañón, Madrid) and a full Professor of Medicine at the Complutense University in Madrid. He completed his fellowship and residency at the San Carlos University Hospital, Madrid. In 1990-1991 Prof. Martin visited the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center and the University of Washington Medical Center at Seattle (EEUU), where he worked on high-dose chemotherapy with bone marrow transplantation for breast cancer. In 1995, Prof. Martin created GEICAM (Spanish Group for Breast Cancer Research), a network involving more than 140 Spanish institutions and, since its foundation, he is the Chairman of the Group. Since 2001, Prof. Martin serves as a member of the Board of Directors and of the Breast Cancer Scientific Steering Committee of TRIO (Translational research in Oncology), an international not-for-profit clinical research organization involving 45 different countries. Prof. Martin has published more than 400 articles in peer-reviewed medical journals.

From October 2015 to December 2017, Dr. Martin held the position of President of the Spanish society of medical oncology (SEOM). The European Society for Medical Oncology (ESMO) bestowed its 2017 ESMO Award on Prof. Martín as a recognition for his contribution to medical oncology development. He was awarded with the Premio Obieta by the Royal Spanish Academy of Medicine to the best professional career in December 2017 and with the 2018 AstraZeneca Foundation Award to the best oncology career in Spain.
